| Step 2: | Choose your Social Studies course. AP will require about 1 hour of study time every night. |
| Step 3: | All freshmen take Biology of the Living Earth |
| Step 4: | Choose your Math course. Current math teacher must approve and sign for your next level math class. |
| Step 5: | Select 2.0 credits of additional courses. <i>A 0.5 credit course is one semester, and a 1.0 credit course is all year long.</i> |
| Step 6: | Choose alternate Courses. Do not choose the same courses as in step 5. Only choose alternate courses you are willing to take. |
| Step 7: | Sign your form on the back, Get your parent / guardian signature. |
