Students looking for the extra push of more challenging work may enroll in the class as space permits. Placement is based on test scores, grades, student self-selection, and/or Teacher recommendation. Contact your counselor if interested in this option.

    Dual Languages - To help ensure that students are successful in a Spanish dual language setting, the Dual Language program is available for students who have been enrolled in a Dual Language program or who have a middle school level of Spanish proficiency.
